

Turning Point's AA Campout

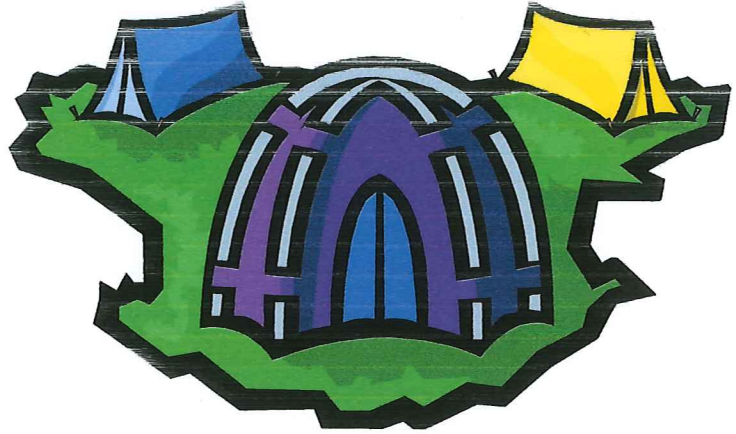
September 13st, 14th, 15th

Via Idaho City: Hwy 21 to Idaho City

Left on Montgomery Street.

Left on Centerville Road – turns into dirt road. Go about 7 miles – dirt road turns to pavement. Turn **Right** onto Grimes Pass Road. Just after the turn, you will see a pond on the right. Stay on this road the rest of the way– it turns back to dirt road after Centerville.

At Pioneerville you will see a sign to Grimes Pass. Keep going- 4 more miles along creek. You will cross the bridge. Take an **immediate left**, and then **immediate right** on the trail that hugs the hill. Pass the first cabin and you are there!

Via Garden Valley: Hwy 55 to Banks.

Right at 'Banks - Lowman' road, (hwy 17) Go straight through Garden Valley. Turn **Right** on the Alder Creek Road. (If you get to the airport, you have gone too far.) Cross the bridge, then, in about a block turn **left**. Dirt road the rest of the way– you will

drive along the South Fork of the Payette for 4 - 5 miles. You will see a sign to Grimes pass and Centerville; turn **Right** here onto Grimes Pass Road. . (This road is steep, winding and narrow, but not very long. Watch ahead and if you see a car coming, there are places to pull over.) You do NOT need to have 4-wheel drive. You will see the sign at the Grimes Pass Summit – make a hairpin turn to the **left**. Come down the hill. You will come to the bridge and see a cabin on the right. Make a sharp **right**, before the bridge, and another sharp **right** onto the trail that hugs the hill. Pass the first cabin, and you are there.
